

## **Minutes for CCP meeting 12th December 2016 Memorial hall 7.30PM**

Minutes of November 28th 2016 were approved and signed.

Chairs Report : The committee were told of the interesting visit to Thornham village hall whilst photographs were passed around so those that could not attend would get a feel about the layout and size. Group discussion on Thornham : Kevin Pell mentioned his excitement at the probability of having a cinema system like the one at Thornham who have a film club as well as live concerts being shown with buffet evenings. He feels we could benefit from the same as a means of income and entertainment to encourage people to attend. The Thornham group have a number of clubs and facilities which we took on board for future reference. Lots of good things but we felt the outdoor pavilion seating area could be more use to us as extra width on the interior.

Karl Tordoff said that the changing rooms at the new build would have to be bigger as they would not meet the requirements of the football association. Sketched plans were passed around to give members more of an idea. These were discussed and agreed to propose at the Parish council meeting on Jan 5th 2017.

The possibility of underwater heating was discussed , however this might be an expensive option so we would have to look at other options to be discussed at a later date with contractors, as would cheaper options on building materials.

Birgit Gipp voiced concerns on vandalism and though there are no guarantees against this possibility. We would be discussing the point with the architect Ian H Bix Associates when this becomes feasible.

Sheila James requested if the Memorial hall was sold that commemorative plaques and photos could be moved to the new build. Agreement for this was unanimous.

Correspondence: A bill was received from St John's Ambulance brigade who attended the August fun-day it was decided to hand this to the Parish council finance group as it is believed it had already been paid.

A letter of resignation was received from Rob Lucas via email. It was agreed to send a reply, which Audrey Winter has sent also via email.

An email was received from Ben & Tracey Duncan asking to be booked for next years Funday. Replied saying that we would be in touch in the new year
