## Clenchwarton Parish Council News April 2018

This month we can report that the evergreen oak tree overhanging a property in Church Road has been tidied up and the canopy slightly raised.

We are still on the case of the overgrown footpath outside Margareta House. No date as yet but apparently Highways have identified a scheme under which to renew it.

More litter bins have been purchased and will be placed in Station Road, Main Road (possibly near the Chapel to replace the one that had become unsafe), Jubilee Bank Road and Hall Road. There have been requests for Clockcase Lane and Ferry Road. However, Parish Council has to consider the cost of having them emptied regularly. **We would also like to advise Parishioners that dog poo can be disposed of in regular litter bins, it doesn't need to be a special bin for dog mess.**

Our spring litter pick was cut short by the weather but 10 bags were collected. A big **THANK YOU** to the two parishioners who battled the weather with me. Another one is planned for the Autumn, date to be announced nearer the time.

The Probation team, organized by County Councillor Kemp, has been in the village and cleared out some dykes in front of the Playing Field. However, nothing can be done in Clapper Lane at the moment due to the dykes being very full.

Another bus shelter is to be purchased. Locations under consideration are near the Victory pub and on the opposite side at the bus stop near Station Road. Feel free to let us know your preference by contacting the Parish Clerk.
