We have received reports on Thursday 14th February of a male in the Terrington St John area knocking doors claiming he was working up the road and when passing the address he noticed that some lead flashing had lifted on the roof. The male then offered to sort it out and got some ladders out, when on the roof he claimed the chimney stack was in danger of collapse and stated he could repair it for £1200. Fortunately the home owner did not take up the offer of help from the male as no doubt the male would have over charged for any work done. This is a recognised rogue trader scam.

Norfolk Police strongly recommend that you visit the Trusted Trader Site on your local council web pages if you need any work done and never take up the offer of services from cold callers.
