

Minutes for CCP meeting 9th January 2017 Memorial hall 7.30 PM

Minutes of meeting 12th December amended then approved and signed after Birgit Gipp pointed out a couple of small clerical errors.

Chairs Report : It was pointed out that now would be the time to make contact with Tim Wall Leisure management advisor since we have now got the go ahead from the Parish council on the new build. The memorial hall valuation has come in at between 175,000/200,000 if sold. We should now submit outline plans for what we need to the architect for the new build. Karl Tordoff pointed out in our basic sketches when the question of no outdoor access to toilets came up that all these points will be made to the architect and also that two separate changing facilities would be required for male and female use. Sophie Adams was asked to look into the cost and benefit of solar panels for the new build.

Correspondence :

A resignation was received from Peter Howlett to which Audrey Winter has replied to thanking him for his time with us.

A letter was received from Jenny Rowe Parish Clerk regarding the size of the parish office on the plans being very small if we needed to host a meeting in there at any time. After discussion with the committee Audrey Winter replied to assure all these things would be discussed with the planners.

Fund-raising : The committee discussed one or two ideas such as bingo, race night and a children's disco. We felt that March half term might be a good time to try a bingo and if it did well we could make it a regular feature throughout the year. The disco might be an idea to tie in with an Easter theme. These and other ideas would be continued with at the next meeting. The committee agreed that the most important thing to get sorted was this years Funday. The date was agreed on for Sunday June 18th from 1PM till 7PM. Self catering from the Pavilion would bring in the best profits. Karl Tordoff would be main contact for entertainments and vendors and advertise on Clenchwarton facebook page. Birgit Gipp felt a newsletter to the public might be a good idea and Audrey Winter agreed to let parish magazine know . Posters and other information would be dealt with at a later meeting.
