Minutes of the meeting 1st March 2018

There were 5 members of the public present

1. To receive apologies for absence: Cllrs Swietonowski, Hunter, Winter, County Councillor Kemp and Borough Councillor Whitby
2. To receive declarations of interest in items on the agenda and any application for dispensation. There were none
3. To approve the minutes of the meeting held 1st February 2018. The minutes were approved and signed as a true record
4. To receive reports from Borough and County Councillors. The clerk read out the reports which had also been circulated to Councillors.
5. Open forum: 15 minutes during which time residents may speak. A resident addressed the Council regarding his application for kennels and cattery at Clock case Lane
6. Finance: (1) to approve the monthly payments for March, finance report circulated by the RFO. The March monthly payments were agreed. Total £1854.45 and to transfer £1500. (2) To agree the payments for February, a new report had been circulated. Agreed. Cllr Gipp did not require a cheque for the bingo.
7. To consider fitting new heads to all the Parish Council owned street lights. Cllr Swietonowski. Agreed to agenda for the April meeting
8. To consider site for the new bus shelter. Cllr Swietonowski. It was resolved to purchase the new shelter as originally agreed. Cllr Tordoff would measure the site as the second shelter may need to be smaller than the first.
9. To resolve on the purchase of cameras for the field and churchyard to catch dogs running free and incidents of dog fouling. Cllr Pell. It was resolved Cllr Pell would bring a camera to the next meeting. It was agreed to purchase a camera for the churchyard and field. Cllr Tordoff would supply the camera awareness signs.
10. Clerks report: Clerk reported she had requested a hard copy of the EIA for the proposed power station on the Willows site when it becomes available. She had received a letter from a resident regarding the AWA lorry's causing damage to Clock case Lane/Millennium Way he wished to know who was paying for the road repairs. He also requested a SAM2 sign for Ferry Road due to the excess speed of vehicle using the road. It was resolved to write to Highways and ask who was paying for the repairs and to see if it is possible to erect the SAM2 in Ferry Road. It was agreed to invite a representative from AWA to the Parish assembly. An email was received from a resident requesting a street light at Clapper Lane/Robin Kerkham Way. It was agreed to write back explaining that the cost of a new light for that area was in excess of £3000 and that there is already a streetlight in the vicinity. A bin was also requested which the Council will consider along with reporting that the paths need cleaning in Robin Kerkham Way.

11. Planning: to make observations on planning applications received and circulated.
17/01934/F Point Farm kennels and cattery, amendment details. Support, but still have concerns regarding the cat and dog mix. 17/01632/RMM reserved matters for 40 dwellings at Fosters Sports Ground. Notification of new property address 226 Main Road. Notification of three new property addresses in Margarett Close 14a, b and c.
12. To receive updates from committees: Community Centre working party committee. Cllr Mallett reported on the progress the committee were making. There would be a bingo on the 10th May, a quiz night on the 18th April and they were setting up a 'just giving' page.
13. To receive reports from outside bodies: Memorial Hall. There would be an AGM on the 12th March at 7pm
14. To receive items for the April 5th 2018 meeting. To consider purchasing another SAM2 speed camera. Cllr Pell
15. To resolve on whether the Council should move into closed session for the discussion of the following agenda items on the grounds of confidentiality (details of the discussion not for publication by virtue of section 100 (a) para 4 of the Local Government Act 1972) Agreed.
