

**Norfolk Knitters and Stitchers (NKaS)** is a charity which knits, sews and crochets "stuff" for charities.

Here in Clenchwarton we run a fortnightly meeting in the village which you are welcome to attend. You don't have to be able to knit, etc. but we could help you learn if you would like to. You may have seen the poppies and daffodils that local premises sell - we make them! We also knit for West Newton ward and the prem-baby unit, various animal charities, chicken jumpers for ex-battery hens, seals for the coastal watch people, and for international aid.

You'll receive 4 monthly newsletters and regular updates on what is needed at the moment!

We also have a meeting of all the West Norfolk groups at Providence Street community centre once a month where you can buy wool, material and more "at advantageous prices", there is a regular raffle plus tea and biscuits. Not too much knitting gets done - it's definitely more natter than knit: but it enables you to drop off "stuff" and see what others are up to.

We have visitors every few months at Providence Street - October was an owl sanctuary which we support.
